

## **Curriculum vitae – Professor Michelle NISOLLE**

Professor NISOLLE was graduated doctor in medicine, surgery and deliveries from the « Université Catholique de Louvain (UCL) » in Belgium in 1983. She obtained her Ph.D Thesis in 1996 on the theme of endometriosis.

She is presently Professor of Gynaecology at the University of Liege in Belgium and Professor of Clinics in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University Hospital of Liege where she is responsible of the Unit of Gynaecological Surgery and performs robotic surgery for benign conditions. She is involved in the surgical teaching of fellows.

She is a member of the Board of the International Society of Gynecological Endoscopy (ISGE). She is a faculty member of ESHRE (special interest group on “Endoscopy in Reproductive Surgery”). She is also a member of many international societies involved in endoscopy and endometriosis and a reviewer of several International Journals (Human Reproduction, Lancet, Gynecological Surgery, International Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Gynecologic and Obstetric Investigation).

Her research is focused primarily on endometriosis and in particular on the physiopathogenesis of endometriosis. The second theme of her research concerns the ovarian cryopreservation.

She is author and co-author of 130 chapters of Books, 189 publications in national and international Journals and 2 Atlas of endoscopic surgery.
