Lukas Rob, MD, PhD, born 1958 in Czech republic, received his medical degree in 1983. He underwent training in obstetrics and gynecology and oncogynecology at the Charles University Prague at the 1st Medical Faculty (till 1996). Since then he has been practising at the 2nd Medical Faculty as the Head of Oncogynecology Center (1996- 2002) and the Vice head of the Obstetrics and Gynecology Department (2000-2002). Currently he is the Head of Obstetrics and Gynecology Department (2002-2010) and head the Centre of Oncogynecology University Hospital Motol (2002-2010). This centre is the largest one in the Czech Republic. Annually there are treated 120-130 women for cervical cancer, 25-30 for vulva cancer and 80-100 for ovarian, 80 endometrial cancer and 100 breast cancer.

Dr. Rob's research is focused on gynecologic oncology, primarily in the area of women's malignancies with particular emphasis on the cervical and vulvar cancer, sentinel lymph nodes in cervical and vulvar cancer, fertility sparing surgery in cervical cancer, precancer lesion – vulvar and cervical, HPV, HPV vaccination and GTD. Dr. Rob is lecturing locally and nationally on the treatment of women with gynecological cancer.

Dr. Rob has published several original papers and abstracts and has given many presentations at scientific meetings internationally.
