Call for Candidates for the EuPA Young Investigator Prize (PhD)

EuPA-YIP. The European Proteomics Association (www.EuPA.org) hereby announces a call for candidates for the EuPA Young Investigator Prize to be awarded at the 3rd EuPA Congress in Stockholm (June 14th - 17th 2009). A special session will be dedicated to presentations which will be given by the finalists selected from the submitted abstracts. The winner, judged by the panel after the presentations, will receive €1.000, sponsored by the Journal of Proteomics, and a EuPA certificate. The winner of the Young Investigator Prize will also be announced in the major proteomics journals.

Eligibility. To qualify, candidates must have obtained their PhD or MD degree, and within three years of completion of their degree at the time of submission, member of a EuPA affiliated society and working in a European laboratory. Candidates can either be nominated by senior researchers (PhD, MD or equivalent) or by a EuPA affiliated national proteomics society.

Submission. Abstracts for this session should be sent with two letters of support to Dr Garry Corthals (firstname.lastname@btk.fi). Registration to the congress will be open at the beginning of 2009 at http://www.malmokongressbyra.se/3rd_eupa_congress/ and ends March 19, 2008.
